Robert W. Hazen passed away Tuesday, Feb. 9, 2010, at Ponca City Medical Center after a lengthy battle with cancer. He was 83. There will be no service at this time. The cremation is under the direction of Trout Funeral Home and Crematory.

Born March 5, 1926, to J.W. and Beulah (Patterson) Hazen, he was a lifelong Ponca City resident. While in high school, he worked at Darr Flight Training School. After graduation, he followed his older brothers, Bill and Jim, into military service.
