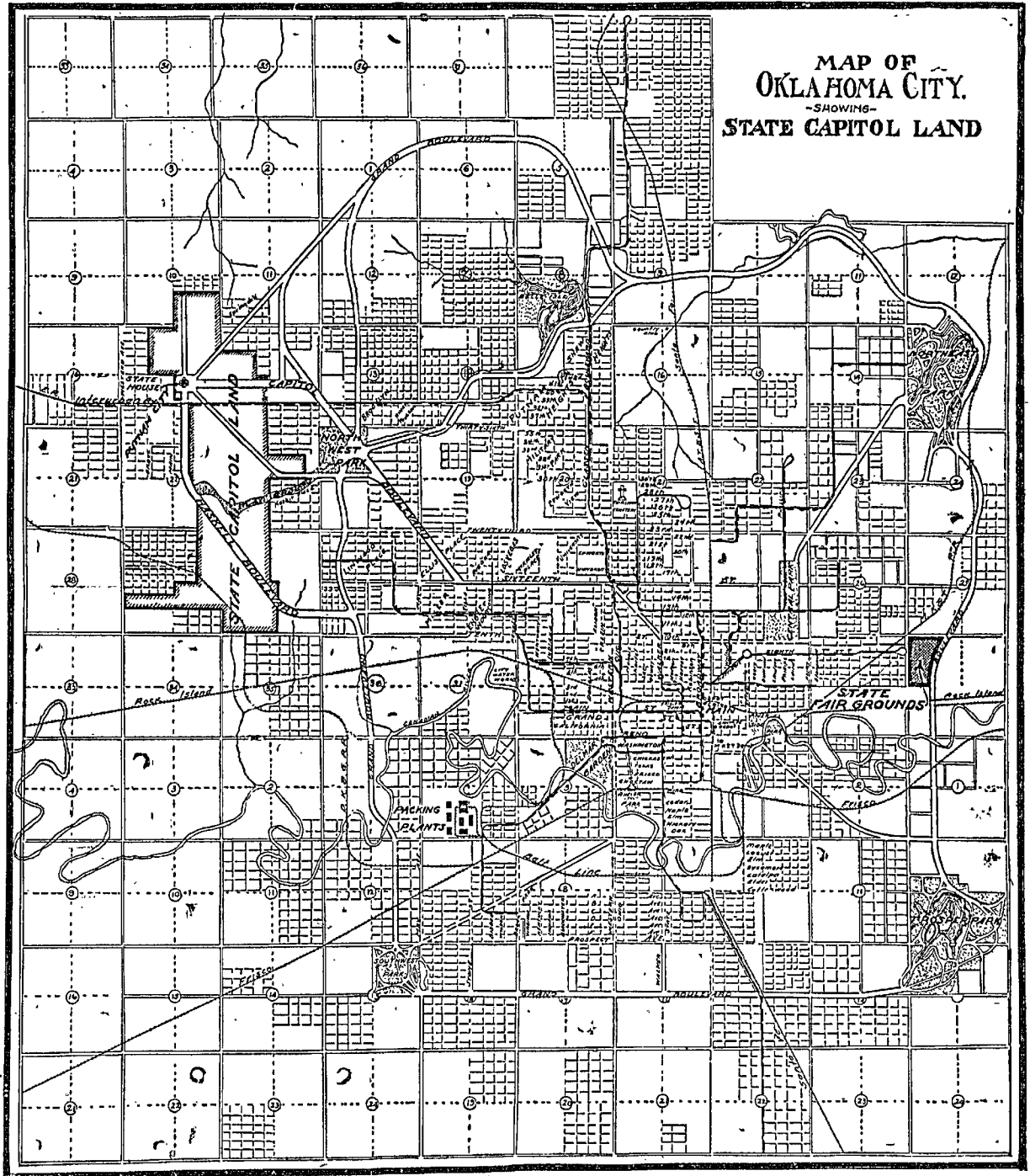


MAP SHOWING COMPLETE SYSTEM OF BOULEVARDS AS PLATTED IN OKLAHOMA CITY'S STATE CAPITOL ADDITION



Above is the first complete and official map of the boulevards and parkings in connection with Oklahoma's state capitol site. The capitol commissioners and all who have been interested in the donation of the site and the platting of the area prophesy that the boulevard system, as indicated in the map, will produce a residential section unequalled by that of any capitol city in the United States. In the map also is shown for the first time the arrangements of drives and topography of the four great city parks which are included in the magnificent boulevard system projected and now under the course of construction by the city park commissioners. Reference to the map shows that Haskell and Capitol boulevards, the two great thoroughfares from the center of the city to the capitol suburb touch the boulevard at convenient and attractive points, the former starting from the grand boulevard at a point four blocks south of Elmwood Place and entering the capitol grounds proper from the south, while the other runs from just beyond the paving on Blaisdell street, through Elm Park, blustering Northwest Park and entering the capitol grounds from the west. The thousands attractive boulevards will be planned by the state capitol commissioners the latter part of the week to be used at the state fair where the commissioners will establish a booth. The booklets will contain about 4,000 words, telling of the plans of the commission for the completed State Capitol Addition, giving facts and figures dealing with conditions in Oklahoma City and in the state. The title of the booklet will be **BOOK OF FACTS**. Every figure and statement in this first announcement of the commissioners will be worked for by the commission. The booklets will not contain the details of the site as to prices on lots, dates of sales, etc. Rather they will be educational, giving the people of this and other states an insight into the plans of the commission and the general plan under which a free state capital is made possible. The money is derived from the factoring of the work of the commission, the going over of abstracts, consultations with engineers, landscape architects, advertising men and the many other features of the preparatory work have had their completed work. It is now within five days of the time to make a definite announcement as to the date of the first sale. That the decision was reached Saturday the State Fair offered an opportunity for explaining the situation in general which should not be ignored. With the issuance of this first booklet, which will be used in the entire campaign, the commissioners are fast reaching a point where they will be able to announce details more definitely. They are now holding day and night sessions in their offices on the second floor of the Security building and the mass of data is quickly being placed in definite shape.
